

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to the 2016-17 school year. Although the summer has gone by quickly, I am very excited to start the school year. This will be my 3rd year teaching 8th grade math and I am excited and ready! This year in math we will be continuing our learning of algebra skills and preparing students for work at the high school level. I am very excited that this year the students will actually be receiving a book for math! The book is a “consumable” which means that it is theirs. They will be writing in it and ripping things out of it. Students will be expected to bring this book every day and take notes in class that will assist in homework completion and studying for tests. Students are responsible to get to class each day, participate, get their homework done and come in for extra help when needed. Note that every day your student is absent, he or she is missing key content. I will be introducing new concepts and only ask that your child stays focused, asks questions and works hard on the materials being taught. When absent it is your student’s responsibility to find out what they missed and complete the work from that day.

As for little bit about me, my name is Kari Cooley. This will be my sixth year of teaching math, which I am extremely passionate about. Not only do I teach, but I am involved with various committees in the district. I have lived in Lorain all my life and am a graduate of Clearview High School and Bowling Green State University. I have my master’s degree in Computer Technology in Education and am always looking for new ways to integrate technology into the classroom. I love sports and still play in volleyball leagues and run the beach leagues and tournaments at Lakeview in the summer. I had coached basketball the past 7 years and recently quit to take care of my family and start a new business endeavor. I have two sons, Callen, who turned 3 this past summer and Deekon, who will be 2 in December. This past summer, my husband and I had our daughter, Paycen, who is now 1 month.

Hillary Rios, our 8th grade intervention specialist, will be an additional teacher in our 1st and 2nd period math classes. We will be teaching all students together in these classes. Ms. Rios also may be in your child’s Reading or Language Arts class depending on his or her schedule. She is in her 1st year of teaching with Clearview Local Schools. She received her undergraduate degree in Business Administration from the University of Toledo and her teaching license in Special Education from Ashland University in May. She has two boys; Hayden, age 10 and Holden, age 4. Hillary will send home another letter with her contact information for you as well.

Along with this letter, each student also received a syllabus of the expectations and programs that we will be using in class this year. Students will be required to complete Study Island blue ribbons quarterly as well as Accelerated Math assignments weekly. I am more than willing to work with students that are without internet access however, the student will be responsible to take care of that work within school hours without me having to remind them. A flyer is also sent home to set up text message/email reminders of homework and tests using Remind. Students are also receiving a Calculator Contract to get signed and returned stating if they have their own personal calculator for class, or if they will need one signed out to them from the school.

Please take note that our first Parent-Teacher conference date will be **Thursday, September 15th**. Please feel free to contact me at any point that you are worried about your child. I respond best to email or you can call and leave a message at the school. You will be receiving access to our online grade book system called PowerSchool. There is a link on the Clearview Website under the Parent tab or under Quicklinks on the 8th Grade Staff Page.

I know that purchasing school supplies can be stressful, however please ensure that your child has his or her binder, dividers, filler paper, calculator, pencils and grading pens for Monday. The rest of the supplies will be needed, throughout the year. I look forward to working with you and your student through the course of the year. My door is always open if you ever want to sit in a class.
