PLACEMENT AGENCY: Spectrum Growth

Spectrum agrees to provide all educational, intervention services and behavioral support to students using intensive therapeutic services and applying principles of Applied Behavioral Analysis in accordance with **Jacob Simmons** Individual Education Program (IEP) and Spectrum's approved course of study. This contract will be in effect for the **2024-2025** school year in conjunction with **Spectrum Growth's** school calendar. The services rendered under this contract include 6.5 hours of instruction daily (for an average of 32.5 hours per week). **Spectrum** commences **August 26**, **2024** and operates through **June 5**, **2025** as indicated on the enclosed calendar. It is anticipated the student(s) will attend **Spectrum Growth** Monday-Friday beginning **August 26**, **2024**.

THE PARTIES AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The term of this Agreement will not exceed one (1) school year thereby expiring on **June 5**, **2025**. In the event that the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) Team determines that the student is not benefiting from the Spectrum program, this agreement may be terminated by either party by giving thirty (30) calendar days prior written notice. If terminated, tuition will be prorated and charged through the effective termination of the contract. The student will be withdrawn on the date of their last day in attendance.
- It is expected that all parties and their respective representatives will conduct themselves in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEA) and related Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3323.
- 3. The services provided under this contract include **Spectrum's** cooperation in the development of **Jacob Simmons** IEP, reevaluations, and attendance at other necessary meetings, which will be coordinated by the **Spectrum** team and **Clearview Local Schools**.
- Spectrum will also provide the <u>Clearview Local Schools</u> quarterly progress reports in accordance with a mutually agreed upon schedule and will cooperate

in scheduling observations or visitations with the Clearview Local Schools as part of the district's ongoing obligation to insure the provision of a Free and Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) to the student. Spectrum also agrees to provide the Clearview Local Schools with all relevant educational records including but not limited to progress reports, report cards, daily attendance records, assessment results, and disciplinary notices.

5. Spectrum further agrees to make staff available on a reasonable basis to support the student's successful transition back into the Clearview Local Schools.

- 6. The Clearview Local Schools is expected to write its own Prior Written Notices (PR01) unless otherwise determined prior to each meeting.
- 7. Spectrum ensures the person(s) providing the services to the student are properly licensed by the Ohio Department of Education, the Autism Scholarship Program and ODJFS licensing agency for support services provided. All staff have successfully completed a criminal background check. Spectrum employs Licensed Intervention Specialists, Licensed General Education Teachers, Board Certified Behavioral Analysts, Speech and Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, and professionals in other related fields pertaining to the education of Special Education,
- 8. Spectrum is a chartered non-public school, as such the local education agency, Lorain City School District, will conduct the re-evaluations of students at the respective buildings. Since the Clearview Local Schools has entered into this contract and is paying said tuition, they must conduct their own re-evaluation of their students and or they can choose to have Lorain do them and may be billed for their cost.
